FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs)

1. What is the duration of MPH course?
It is 2 years.
2. When do the academic session/classes start?
July onwards of every year.
3. How many students are admitted each year?
A maximum of twenty (20) students per batch per year.
4. How many batches are admitted in a year?
Only one batch
5. When was the first batch of students admitted & training commenced?
The first batch of students was admitted during June- July, 2014 and the classes commenced from 11 July, 2014.
6. When will the next batch of students be admitted / the classes will begin?
The next batch of students will be admitted in 27/10/2020 and the classes will start from 11/11/2020.
7. How are the students selected and admitted to this course?
The students are admitted on merit basis following an entrance test which is due on 24/09/2020 . Inservice (MBBS) candidates are exempted from PGET and are admitted as per the deputation list from the Health Department.
8. What is the tuition fees payable by the student per year?
A total sum of INR. 49,200/- is payable as fees per year.
9. Whether any scholarship or stipend is paid to the students?
The Indian candidates other than inservice (MBBS), will get a monthly stipend of INR 20,000/- (Twenty thousand only). (Terms and conditions apply)
